Washington County Heritage Center Site Manager opening

The Washington County Historical Society (WCHS) is seeking a full-time Historic Site Manager for the Washington County Heritage Center in Stillwater. This is a year-round position (approximately 40 hours per week) responsible for daily operations and overall site management. Salary range \$45,000-\$48,000 per year, no medical benefits offered.

Position Overview

The Site Manager serves as the on-site leader and primary representative of the Heritage Center, overseeing operations, coordinating volunteers, and ensuring a high-quality visitor experience while supporting WCHS's mission to preserve and share the history of the St. Croix Valley.

Key Responsibilities include: Manage daily operations, admissions, retail, and facility readiness; Oversee revenue tracking using Square POS and coordinate reporting with QuickBooks; recruit, train, schedule, and support volunteers; ensure exhibits are well maintained and engaging; coordinate education center programs, rentals, and events.; Manage the WCHS Store, including inventory and merchandising and promote the Heritage Center through community outreach and partnerships.

Qualifications include: experience managing a historic site, museum, or cultural organization, strong organizational, leadership, and communication skills, experience coordinating volunteers, familiarity with Square POS and QuickBooks preferred and availability for occasional evenings and weekends.
